


Rockford Family Planning Foundation PROSPECTUS

The Need

The brand new clinic will serve Southwestern and Central Wisconsin, including the Madison metro area, Cedar Rapids, eastern lowa, and northwestern Illinois. Rockford is the fourth largest city in Illinois and currently lacks any abortion services. Only one hour from O'Hare airport, Rockford Family Planning Center, and on a bus route from the airport, we will also serve patients flying from states with no access. Additionally, access in neighboring states like Michigan remains in limbo. The Rockford Family Planning Foundation is creating a state-of-the-art clinic; trusted, safe, and welcoming for our patients.

Studies show that patients who must travel over two hours for abortion services are significantly less likely to receive care. There are currently no care options for Madison and Southeastern Wisconsin that are less than two and a half hours away, and wait times for existing Illinois clinics are increasingly long due to demand. Your support today will allow us to provide crucial care for thousands of people across the Midwest.



Our Partners

We are working with an experienced clinic manager and registered nurse who were a part of the care team in the former Rockford abortion clinic.. Our doctors are experienced obstetrician gynecologists with decades of abortion care experience. We're rapidly recruiting an experienced clinical workforce, specialized in reproductive and women's health, and, especially, abortion care.

Our board of directors is led by Jeanne Bissell, who led the effort to build the onlyabortion clinic in Madison, WI over a decade ago. Her leadership and experience is invaluable. The board consists of fierceabortion advocates from both southern Wisconsin and northern Illinoisdedicated to our mission.

The Rockford Family Planning Foundation is raising \$1.5 million dollars in start up funds to open the clinic.

Significant investment is needed prior to opening our doors to patients. Philanthropy allows us to fund insurance, staff wages and benefits computer systems and technology, electronic medical records, security and other operational costs. The clinic will be self-sustaining within two years, so your support today ensures we can open and provide care as soon as possible.

We are working alongside Rockford elected and public safety officials, building a strong coalition of local support across Rockford.
There is an established group of local volunteers and abortion activists in Rockford, Winnebago County Citizens for Choice, who are continuing to advocate for our mission and provide volunteers and resources.

Family Planning providers from Wisconsin are applying for and being granted their Illinois medical licenses, so that as soon as the clinic is open, we can offer the full sprectrum of abortion services.

The Rockford Family Planning Foundation is also committed to the education and training of abortion services as a crucial component of healthcare. Currently in the United States, complex family plannina, including abortion, is mandated curriculum of obstetrician gynecologist training. In states such as Wisconsin, where there is no abortion access, there are no longer training opportunites for medical students, and, espeically, Ob-Gyn residents. We plan to partner with medical schools and departments of obstetrics and gynecology so that Rockford Family Planning Center can become a crucially needed training facility for this crucial reproductive healthcare.




Where You Come In
